Cordillera Dog Park Rules and Regulations

A person responsible for a dog shall comply with the following rules and regulations at the Cordillera Dog Park. These rules and regulations apply to any person who brings a dog to the Cordillera Dog Park, including, without limitation, property owners, property owner's dog walkers, handlers or trainers.

Call Cordillera Public Safety at 970-926-2335 for assistance.

The designated off-leash exercise area at the Cordillera Dog Park is open from 6 a.m. to 9 p.m.

- No person may bring into the Cordillera Dog Park:
 - A known dangerous or aggressive dog
 - A female dog in heat
 - A dog that does not have a current rabies vaccination tag or dog license tag
 - More than two dogs at one time
- Dogs must be within eye sight and kept under voice control at all times.
- Dogs may not be left unattended.
- Dogs must be removed from the Cordillera Dog Park immediately at the first sign of aggression, whether toward a dog, a person or wildlife.
- Dog waste must be removed completely and immediately and disposed of properly.
- Glass bottles are prohibited.
- Dog bites must be reported to Eagle County Animal Services at 970-328-3647.
- Children must be accompanied by an adult.
- A person responsible for a dog must have in his/her possession a leash for the dog which shall be worn by the dog at all times that the dog is not in the Cordillera Dog Park.
- Smoking and controlled substances are prohibited.
- Profanity, recklessness, disruptive behavior, trespassing and vandalism are prohibited and may be punishable by law and/ or fine.

Events

No events may be conducted at the Cordillera Dog Park without the prior approval of the Cordillera Metro District. Approval may be obtained by contacting the administration office at 970-926-1923.

Emergencies

- Emergencies, injuries, accidents and/or vandalism, should be reported to Eagle County Sheriff's Office at 911.
- Animal-related complaints should be reported to Eagle County Animal Services at 970-328-3647.
- Wildlife issues should be reported to the Colorado Department of Parks and Wildlife at 970-255-6100.
- Unsafe conditions or damages to the Cordillera Dog Park should be reported to Cordillera Public Safety at 970-926-2335.
